



Directions to Chico Air Museum

Driving In

The Chico Air Museum is located on the flightline of the Chico Municipal Airport (KCIC) in Chico, California, (Northern Sacramento Valley). The Outdoor Museum can be found just south of the Air Traffic Control Tower next to the main terminal. Just 40 yards south of the Outdoor Museum is the original CAAF Administration building that now houses the Indoor collections and displays and gift shop. There is also a sandwich shop (the Sub Station) located in the front of the building toward the flightline.

Chico Municipal Airport is located approximately 5 miles north of the City of Chico. Take Cohasset Rd north. Turn left (west) at Airpark Blvd (the second airport entrance). Before reaching the terminal entrance, turn left (south) on Fortress Street. Drive one block and turn right (west) on Convair Ave. The Indoor Museum is at the end of the cul-de-sac and always flies the American Flag when open.

Flying-in

If you are flying in, request with ground control that you would like to taxi to "the Sub Station Deli", about 100 yards south of the control tower. You will see the outdoor display aircraft at the base of the tower. Once parked, there is a walk-thru gate directly in front of the Sub Station. Directions to re-enter the secure area are indicated on the flightline side of the gate. There is a TSA restricted area on the ramp NORTH of the control tower and should not be entered on foot or when taxiing. It is a box that is outlined in red on the ramp and is in front of the main terminal. Consult your Airmen's Information Manual or approved publications. Chico Air Museum is opened Friday, Saturday and Sunday 9-4 or by prior arrangement
